WHAT DOES KINGSBURY FINANCIAL MANAGEMENT, INC. (KFMI) DO WITH YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION?

Why?	Financial companies choose how they share your personal information. Federal law gives consumers the right to limit some but not all sharing. Federal law also requires us to tell you how we collect, share, and protect your personal information. Please read this notice carefully to understand what we do.
What?	The types of personal information we collect and share depend on the product or service you have with us. This information can include: " Social Security number and trading experience " assets and investment experience " trading frequency and technology infrastructure When you are <i>no longer</i> our customer, we continue to share your information as described in this notice.
How?	All financial companies need to share customers' personal information to run their everyday business. In the section below, we list the reasons financial companies can share their customers' personal information; the reasons KFMI chooses to share; and whether you can limit this sharing.

Definitions	
Affiliates	Companies related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies.
	KFMI does not currently have any active affiliates.
Nonaffiliates	Companies not related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies.
	 Nonaffiliates can include financial companies such as securities firms, trading firms and nonfinancial companies such as software firms.
Joint marketing	A formal agreement between nonaffiliated financial companies that together market financial products or services to you.
	 Our joint marketing partners can include web site advertising partners.

Other important information

Do Not Call Policy. This notice is the Kingsbury Financial Management, Inc. (KFMI) Do Not Call Policy under the Telephone Consumer Protection Act, We do not solicit via telephone numbers listed on the state or federal Do Not Call Lists, unless the law allows. KFMI employees receive training on how to document and process telephone marketing choices. Consumers who ask not to receive telephone solicitations from KFMI will be placed on the KFMI Do Not Call List and will not be called in any future campaigns, including those of KFMI affiliates. If you communicate with us by telephone, we may monitor or record the call.
